Comments:

Psalm 15

Abide- to sojourn, abide, dwell in, dwell with, remain inhabit, be a stranger, to seek hospitality with, to assemble oneself.

Tabernacle- the sacred tent of Jehovah

Holy Hill- holiness of God

Uprightly- complete, whole, entire, sound, having integrity.

Righteousness- of God a covenant- keeping in redemption, of people enjoying salvation. Speaketh the truth in his heart.

Truth- faithfulness reliability, a body of ethical or religious knowledge.

Backbite- to be a talebearer, slander, go about.

Reproach- scorn, taunt, resting upon condition of shame, disgrace.

Contemned- to despise, hold in contempt, to be despicable.

Usury- interest

Vile person- abominably wicked, morally despicable, disgusting to the emotions, tend to degrade.

Lord, who shall sojourn, **dwell in the sacred tent of Jehovah.**

1. He that **walks complete, whole, having integrity,** and work of God a **covenant, keeping in redemption, of people enjoying salvation.** Speaks the **truth** in his heart.
2. He that is a talebearer, **slander not with his tongue,** nor does evil to his neighbor, nor takes up a taunt, scorn, resting upon condition of shame, disgrace against his neighbor.
3. Whose eyes a **vile person despises,** hold in contempt, to be despicable; but he honors them that fear the LORD.
4. He swore to his own hurt and **change not.**
5. He that **puts not out his money to interest,** nor take reward against the innocent.
6. He that does these things **shall never be moved.**
