The period between Jesus' Final departure from Galilee and His Last Week is usually spoken of as the Perea, or Later Judean, Ministry—partly in Perea and partly Judea:

Perea east of Jordan - in Herod jurisdiction; Judea west of Jordan, under Pilate's jurisdiction.

Jesus's human dependence upon Prayer

Our Lord's engagement in prayer occurs only twice in Matthew —
cps. 14:23; 27:46

And twice in Mark — (chps. 6:46; 15:34).

In Luke the prayer life of Jesus is shown over and over again.
