



## Psalm 91

### Concepts:

1. He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
2. **Shadow** is the protection and symbol of transitoriness of life.
3. The Lord is my **refuge** (shelter) and my **fortress** (net or stronghold) my God. In Him do I trust.
4. He shall deliver thee from **snare** (trap) of the **fowler** (trapper). Bait-layer and **noisome** pestilence (iniquity, mischief, mischievous, naughtiness, very wickedness. **Pestilence** (plague).
5. He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his **wings** and His truth shall be thou. (garment)
6. Thou shall not be afraid for the terror nor for the arrow that flieth by day.

7. A thousand shall fall at thy side and ten thousand at thy right hand. But it shall not come near thee.
8. With thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.
9. Thy has made the Lord thy habitation,
10. No evil shall befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.
11. Thou shalt **tread** upon the lion and **adder**. (march or lead) adder (snake). Trample over the lion and dragon. Because He hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.
12. He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.
13. With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation.



## Psalm 46

### Concepts

1. God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. (shelter from rain or storm, from danger and falsehood).
2. Will not we fear:
  - A. Though the earth be removed
  - B. Though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea,
  - C. Though the waters roar and be troubled.
  - D. Though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof.
3. There is a river, the streams shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High.
4. God is in the midst of her. God shall help her. He uttered his voice and the earth melted.
5. The Lord of hosts is with us.
6. Behold the works of the LORD.
  - A. He makes wars to cease unto the end of the earth.

B. He breaketh the bow and cutteth the spear in sunder  
(pieces),

C. He burneth the chariot in the fire,

7. Be still and know that I am God.

8. I will be exalted in the earth.

9. The God of Jacob is our refuge.
