Qualifications & Rules Qualifications & Rules

Qualifications:

To be considered for nomination, the applicant must:

- Be an active member of Zion Baptist Church and continue active involvement in at least one ZBC Ministry
- Be a June candidate for a high school diploma, and/or currently enrolled in college (and/or higher learning institution)
- Have a 3.0 grade point average and must maintain a 2.8gpa for future eligibility
- Demonstrate Christ like qualities in church ministries, school and the community through school programs and/or community service above and beyond what is required
- (Additional Qualifications for Graduate Students)
 - 1. Proof of Enrollment
 - 2. Copy of Conferred Undergraduate Degree
 - 3. Minimum of 3.0 GPA

Rules:

- 1. Only original application is accepted.
- 2. Original application must be returned to the Zion Baptist Church office or hand-delivered to a member of the Scholarship Committee by May 6, 2024.
- 3. Application must be complete and all required items attached-*essay, updated transcript, SAT or ACT official score and **letter of reference.
- 4. If already received, the letter of acceptance from the college or university is to be included.
- 5. Failure to provide original application and all required information will result in disqualification.
- 6. Submission of an application is not a guarantee of a scholarship.
