House of Wisdom

Righteousness delivers from death

House of Folly

Ill-gotten treasures have no lasting value. (obtained by evil, unlawful or dishonest)

He **thwarts** the craving of the wicked. (Prevent someone from accomplishing something)

Lazy hands make for poverty.

He who sleeps during harvest is a disgraceful son.

Violence overwhelms the mouth of the wicked.

The name of the wicked will not be used in blessings.

A chattering fool comes to ruin.

Whoever takes crooked paths will be found out.

Whoever winks **maliciously** causes grief. (intending to do harm)

Hatred stirs up conflict.

The Mouth of the wicked conceals violence.

A Rod is for the back of one who has no sense.

Poverty is the ruin of the poor.

The earnings of the wicked are sin and death.

Whoever ignores correction leads others astray.

Whoever conceals hatred with lying lips and spreads slander is a **fool**. (person acts unwisely)

The heart of the wicked is of little value.

Fools die for lack of sense.

A fool finds pleasure in wicked schemes.

What the wicked dread will overtake them.

When the storm has swept by, the wicked are gone.

As vinegar to the teeth and smoke to the eyes, so are sluggards to those who send them.

The years of the wicked are cut short.

The hopes of the wicked come to nothing.

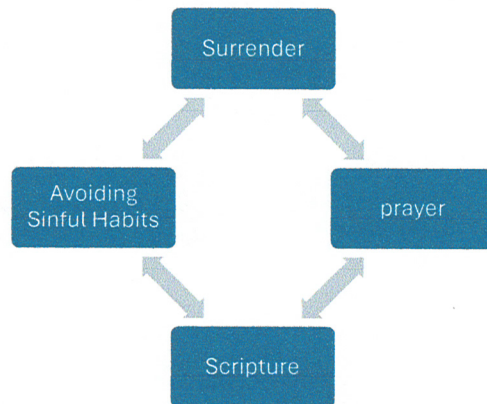
The way of the Lord is the ruin of those who are evil.

The wicked will not remain in the land.

A perverse tongue will be silent.

The mouth of the wicked only what is **perverse**. (Of a person or their actions showing a deliberate and obstinate desire to behave in a way that is unreasonable.)

4 Ways to Grow in the Holy Spirit



Surrender and Submission: Actively give up the effort of trying to live the Christian life on your own and surrender control to the Holy Spirit.

Prayer and Reflection: Dedicate time to pray, allowing the Spirit to lead your prayer life and interject into your schedule. Take time for quiet solitude to be more open to the Spirit's voice.

Read Scripture: Immerse yourself in Scripture to understand God's will and be reminded of the teachings and example of Jesus.

Walk in the Spirit: Be intentional about living in a way that pleases the Spirit rather than the flesh. This includes cultivating forgiveness and grace and being attentive to the Spirit's guidance.
